**Robbery Suspects face additional charges;
Additional suspect arrested**

On Tuesday, March 24, 2009, at approximately six minutes after midnight, a female resident of Colonial Grand at Monte D'oro was robbed by three black male suspects. These suspects, who were armed with a shotgun, took property belonging to the victim. The victim was not injured.

Hoover Police Detectives have charged the suspects listed below with Robbery 1st Degree, with a \$60,000 bond for each suspect. These suspects are in custody in the Jefferson County Jail (Birmingham).

On March 25, 2009, the Hoover Police issued the following email alert:

Possible robbery suspects and vehicle:

*Be on the alert for a late model red or maroon 4 door, sports type car (possibly Toyota Camry, Nissan Maxima, Pontiac G6 type) occupied by 3 black males. The vehicle may have a broken taillight on the passenger's side. 1 black male is approximately 5'4" - 5'7" and weighs 135 -150 lbs., 2nd black male is 5'7" - 5'9" and weighs 150-165 lbs., 3rd black male is 5'10 - 6'0" and weighs 220 - 240 lbs. The suspects are believed to have robbed 1 individual in an apartment complex parking lot in Hoover and others in Birmingham, Homewood, and Vestavia Hills. The subjects usually wear black ski masks, black gloves, and have been armed with a shotgun or rifle. They appear to randomly drive around looking for people to follow home and rob as they exit their cars. They have committed these crimes between the hours of 9 pm and 2 am. If the vehicle or individuals are spotted call 911 and record the tag number **if it can be done safely**. Any information should be forwarded to Sgt.
